

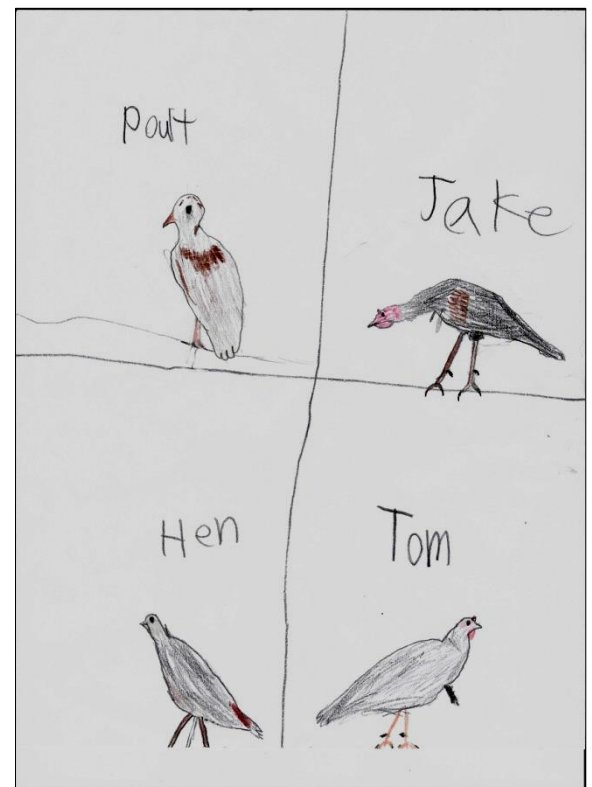


# The Prudence Wave

## Eiffel Tower

If you think of France what do you think of? Maybe the Notre Dame cathedral, or the Disneyland in Paris, or even Mont Saint-Michel. But the thing you will probably think of first is the Eiffel Tower in Paris. Not many people know much about it except that it's made of wrought-iron and it's tall. Well it's much more than that! It has meteorology equipment and restaurants it has a souvenir shop and even a skating rink 187 ft. over Paris. Even fewer people know about its history so I may be able to tell you a thing or two about its history.

The design was made by the French civil engineer Gustave Eiffel but he borrowed the idea from Maurice Koechlin and Emile Nouguier. Maurice and Emile wanted to enter it in to a contest for the centerpiece for the 1889 World Fair. Gustave seeing something bigger in the design wanted to help out engineer the 1,024 ft. tall project to greatness. Many bridges and metal structures were designed by Gustave Eiffel before he helped on the Tower. They knew how to make it structurally sound but not pretty so they brought in another person on their team: Stephen Sauvestre an architect, to make it nicer. Not many people were happy about the building, calling it a “gigantic black smokestack” It was still built (obviously) The work was started on Jan 26, 1887 and finished on March 31, 1889. That means that the 120<sup>th</sup> anniversary was on March 31, 2019!

Gustavo is dead now but his work on the Eiffel Tower lives on for all to see. They have now added LEDs covering the outside and on anniversaries they light up along with fireworks in a rainbow of colors. Why don't you visit the Eiffel Tower?!?!

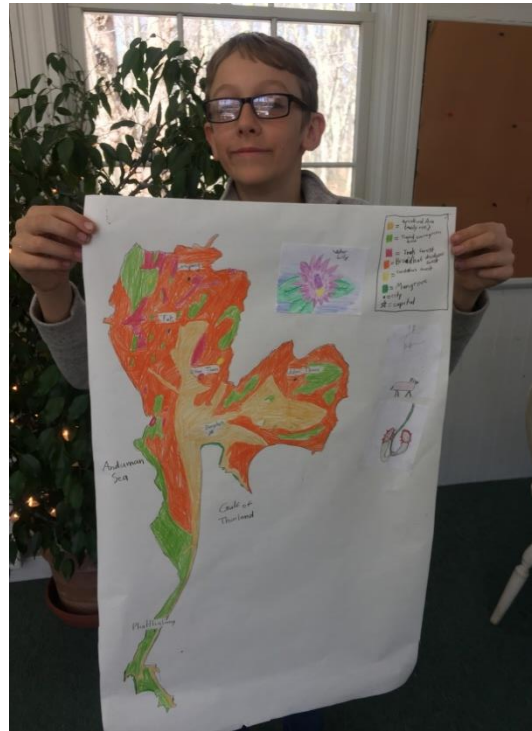
It smells the same as it tastes herbal, flowery, and pungent.

# The Chickadee Mailman

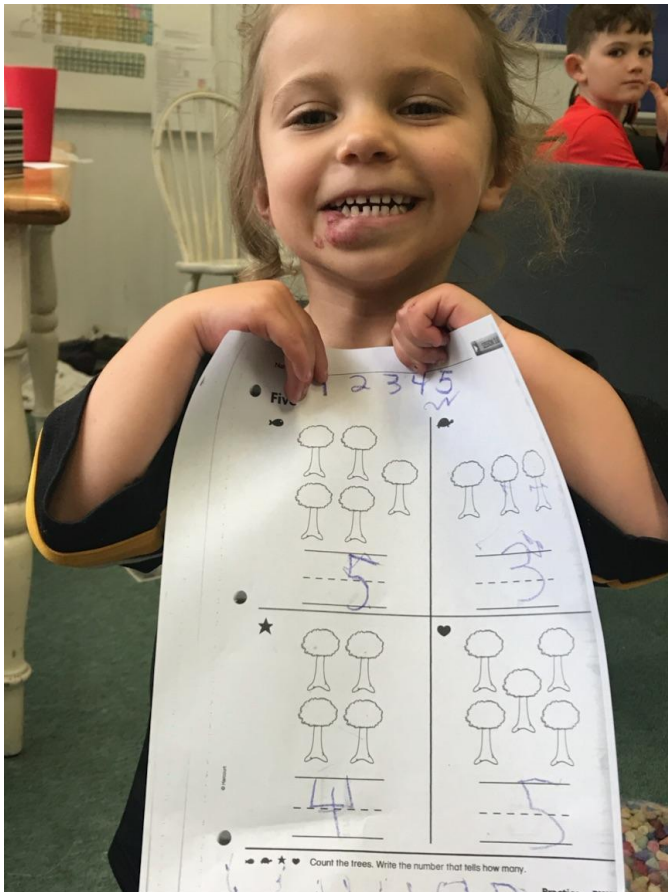
